Journeys/Activities

At Richard Hale School, there will be activities which will require your child to go off school premises under staff supervision, eg sporting events, field trips, theatre/museum visits, etc. To reach the location of these activities your child may have to walk, travel in a minibus or coach, or use other public or private transport.

Please read the following information:

- There may be occasions when your child may be taken by a member of staff in his/her car to hospital or home, or to sporting fixtures and other activities.
- If your child urgently requires medical treatment during an out-of-school activity and it is not possible to contact any of the contacts that we have, the teacher in charge of the party will be authorised to give consent on your behalf.
- Students will normally be dismissed from school for events taking place at the end of or extending beyond the school day. Students/parents will be informed where different arrangements are made.
- For major activities, and for any event involving an overnight stay or participation in a hazardous activity, full details will be given and parental consent sought for the individual activity or trip.

Photographs and Recordings

You may be aware that there are new data protection rules that came in from May 2018. To ensure that we are meeting the new requirements, we need to seek your consent to take and use photographs and/or recordings of your child. We really value using photographs of students, to be able to showcase what students do in school and show what life at our school is like to others. We use these photos in the school's prospectus, on the school's website, the school's Facebook page, Twitter feed and on display boards around school.
