So, for this lesson I am giving you a set of essay-type questions about random topics. I would like you to find 2 opposing views on those questions, summarise them and then come to a conclusion, stating your own opinion, in German.

Here are the questions:

1. Ein Europa, eine Sprache! Ist das wünschenswert?
2. Die Olympischen Spiele – Segen oder Fluch für das Gastland?
3. Es ist viel besser, ein Buch zu lesen, statt die Verfilmung zu sehen. Was meinen Sie?
4. Alle Menschen sollten im eigenen Land bleiben. Sind Sie auch dieser Meinung?

dürfen

sollen

wollen

mögen
