



Richard Hale School: Summer School 2021

The Richard Hale Summer School took place from Monday 26th July to Friday 30th July and was designed to provide transition support to the new Year 7 cohort joining Richard Hale School in September 2021.

A fully funded place for five days was planned for each of the 180 students due to start at Richard Hale School in September 2021. Of these, 160 places were accepted and delivered throughout the week.

32 members of staff were involved in delivering sessions across 9 subjects throughout the week, with many more supporting with the organisation and logistics in advance. Activities included a murder mystery in History, learning ukulele chord patterns in Music and making pizza in Food Technology. Students also had sessions in English and Maths to support their academic transition in light of school closures earlier in the academic year, and subjects such as Business Studies which were brand new for these students. Overall, it was a successful week and an enjoyable introduction to life at Richard Hale School for the students. A full timetable of the week can be found on page 2 of this document.

The school was allocated £24,712.28 in funding:

- Staffing costs: £20,161
- Resources and catering: £4,551
